SUBJECT: PROPOSED CHANGE TO AMERICAN LEGION RIDERS ALASKA BY-LAWS , ARTICLE 4, ADDING ADDITION OFFICER DUTIES.

WHEREAS, The American Legion Riders Alaska, elects Association Officers annually and are approved by the American Legion Department of Alaska, and

WHEREAS, the American Legion Riders By-Laws provide no duties for the elected position of Chaplain, Membership Chairman, Historian or Webmaster, and

WHEREAS, the by adding the duties for the positions of Chaplain, Membership Chairman, Historian and Webmaster. The Association's By-Laws for the American Legion Riders Alaska will provide better guidance to all elected officers Association of the American Legion Riders Alaska, and

WHEREAS, to during the American Legion Department of Alaska Convention the American Legion Riders Alaska find it necessary to amend American Legion Riders Alaska By-Laws; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the American Legion Department of Alaska in Convention assembled at Post 35 between the dates of April 23-25, 2026, that the American Legion Riders Alaska being a program of the American Legion Department of Alaska will amend American Legion Riders Alaska By-Laws, Article 4 replacing the text in Section F and adding Sections G through K. The new Officer Duties will be described as follows:

Section F. *Chaplain:* provides invocation at regular meetings or other activities as may be required by the general membership

Section G. *Membership Chairman:* promotes American Legion Rider membership, can help collect eligibility documentation at the State and local level, and provides membership reports at regular meetings.

Section H. *Historian:* compiles and maintains records to document activities of the Department, both written and photographic. The Historian may also serve as the Webmaster.

Section I. *Webmaster:* updates AlaskaLegionRiders.org as needed to include ALRA communications, meeting minutes, Calls to Meetings, Officer listing, and upcoming rides are provided. Also to admin the ALRA social media presence.

The current Section F will be become Section J as it is the final section in Article 4.
