SUBJECT: PROPOSED CHANGE TO AMERICAN LEGION RIDERS ALASKA BY-LAWS , ARTICLE 3, ADDING SUBPARAGRAPH 1. AND 2. TO SECTION D.

WHEREAS, The American Legion Riders Alaska, having the requirement to hold officer elections prior to Department of Alaska Convention, and

WHEREAS, the current By-Laws for the American Legion Riders Alaska does not specify how many votes any Chapter delegates may cast, and

WHEREAS, the current By-Laws for the American Legion Riders Alaska provide no means for alternate delegates or voting in the absence of selected delegates from any Chapter, and

WHEREAS, to ensure representation for each chapter during the American Legion Department of Alaska Convention the American Legion Riders Alaska find it necessary to amend American Legion Riders Alaska By-Laws; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the American Legion Department of Alaska in Convention assembled at Post 35 between the dates of April 22-25, 2026, that the American Legion Riders Alaska being a program of the American Legion Department of Alaska will amend American Legion Riders Alaska By-Laws by adding the following subparagraphs, to Article 3 Section D:

Subparagraph 1. Each duly designated delegate or alternate shall be entitled to one vote.

Subparagraph 2. The vote of an absent registered delegate shall be cast by the majority of the members present from the absent delegate's Chapter.
