RESOLUTION NO. **RESOLUTION #2026-04**
SUBJECT: PROPOSED CHANGE TO AMERICAN LEGION RIDERS ALASKA
BY-LAWS , ARTICLE 13, ADDING SECTION D.

WHEREAS, according to Robert's Rules of Order amending an organization's By-Laws is crucial for keeping organizations functional, and

WHEREAS, Robert's Rules encourages creating By-Laws that can't be too easily amended, but amending them isn't so difficult that you can't consider making changes within a reasonable time when necessary, and

WHEREAS, having updated and current By-Laws helps to ensure the ALRA remains relevant to the Mission, and

WHEREAS, the current By-Laws for the American Legion Riders Alaska state that it is necessary to circulate amendments to the authorized voting membership within 30 days of its vote, and

WHEREAS, the American Legion Riders Alaska has found that having some flexibility of approving an amendment although the 30-day notice requirement has not been met, and

WHEREAS, to ensure that the rights of all members continue to be protected, amendments considered without proper notice should not be changed without a minimum of two-thirds vote but a higher threshold can be established; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the American Legion Department of Alaska in Convention assembled at Susitna Valley Post 35 between the dates of April 22-25, 2026, that the American Legion Riders Alaska being a program of the American Legion Department of Alaska will amend American Legion Riders Alaska By-Laws by adding the following Section to Article 13 - By-Laws Amendments and Revision:

Section D. An amendment not having been previously read or distributed as required in Section B, will be adopted by the unanimous vote of the voting ALRA membership in attendance.
